Dear QB Club Member:

We hope this letter finds you doing well in 2011. We are writing you to ask for your continued support of Lumberton High School Football with your 2011 membership renewal of \$100 to the LFA QB Club. We were able to generate 55 memberships in 2009 and retain about 42 of you in 2010. Without that \$4,200 it would have been very difficult if not impossible to fund the program at minimal levels. The funds this year will go to help with team meals, filming equipment, and once again, Gatorade. We are going to have to forgo any coaches uniforms this year as the LFA and the QB Club budget it just too tight.

The original idea behind the QB Club was to take some burden off of the LFA and use the QB Club funds for coach's uniforms, equipment related to video and game film, software for statistical needs and team meals. As an example, it cost about \$350 per year to film all the games. Teams meals are \$5,000 for 10 games, not including the playoffs. Our goal is to get to 150 members. When that occurs, we hope to implement the plans for a "Casino Night" and "Meet the Coach Night" among other events. In the meantime, we are in the process of scheduling several 7 on 7 games for the summer which should give all of us good insight into the upcoming season and we would love you to come watch these events. Lumberton will have 5 home games this year including **Cape Fear, Jack Britt and Southview**. In addition to those games, **Seventy-First and Athens Drive** has been added to the non-conference schedule. There is no doubt that this year's schedule will be one of the toughest in the state at any level; probably top 5.

With that said, your continued support is critical to these kids having success. Please mail your \$100 2011 membership dues to LFA QB Club, PO Box 31, Lumberton, NC 28359.
